Lawrence Komnick Memorial Scholarship Award

The Lawrence Komnick Memorial Scholarship is named after Local 246 Auto Mechanic Lawrence E. Komnick, who worked in the New York City Police Department, assigned to the Fleet Services Division Truck Shop, and was killed on the job. He was a member of Roadside Repair, which services numerous trucks and emergency service equipment in the field. Lawrence, often known as Roadside Larry, was always willing to help any command, especially the Emergency Service Unit, in keeping their vehicles up and running. His tragic death had a profound impact upon the union, the units that he served, his friends, family, and the Department

Local 246 established the scholarships in his name, for Active Dues paying member's dependent children.

The scholarship is a \$1,500.00 award and is a one-time only grant. Applicants must be completed and postmarked by April 28, 2023, and include an official transcript of either SAT or ACT scores (Act scores will be converted using the standard SAT/ACT CONVERSION CHART) that is signed and verified by the high school. Members' dependent children graduating high school in June 2023 are eligible to apply. The names of those received with the top 10 highest SAT scores will be put into a raffle and four names will be picked to receive this scholarship award. Drawing for the four scholarships will take place at the May 2023 General Membership Meeting.
